Accomplishments

Currently directing a system-wide, 18-month Performance Management rollout in partnership with HR leadership, overseeing end-to-end program design, communication planning, change management, and enterprise implementation. The initiative is structured into three phases—Check-Ins, Goal Setting, and Performance Management—each launched with a 5-minute overview eLearning course supported by detailed instruction guides and live training sessions to ensure organization-wide adoption and readiness.

Developed and led the enterprise-wide Data Governance Campaign, delivering an eLearning module and a gamified final assessment to reinforce proper file storage and sharing practices. Implemented LMS-tracked scoring with a weekly updated leaderboard displayed on the LMS home banner to drive engagement. Partnered with Public Relations to design and distribute the Data Governance Challenge newsletter to all employees, increasing awareness and participation. Coordinated prize incentives for top performers to sustain motivation and completion rates.

Designed and developed organization-specific compliance courseware to replace vendor-provided training, streamlining the enterprise compliance program. Implemented a task- and role-based learning approach that reduced required employee training hours by 30%, eliminating more than 4,500 non-productive training hours and improving overall workforce efficiency.

Developed an interactive new hire onboarding portal featuring a centralized dashboard with links to company information, employee benefits, and essential resources. Designed week-to-week onboarding curricula that guided employees through required compliance training and role-based learning. Integrated gamified activities to reinforce key terminology and concepts frequently used in their roles, improving engagement and knowledge retention.
